The Ministry of Home Affairs, Govt. of India with support from UNDP is implementing the GoI-UNDP Disaster Risk Reduction Programme (2009-12) in the State of Himachal Pradesh. In the first phase, a Disaster Risk Reduction Project approved by the GoI-UNDP is to be implemented in three selected districts viz. Kangra, Mandi & Kinnaur.
