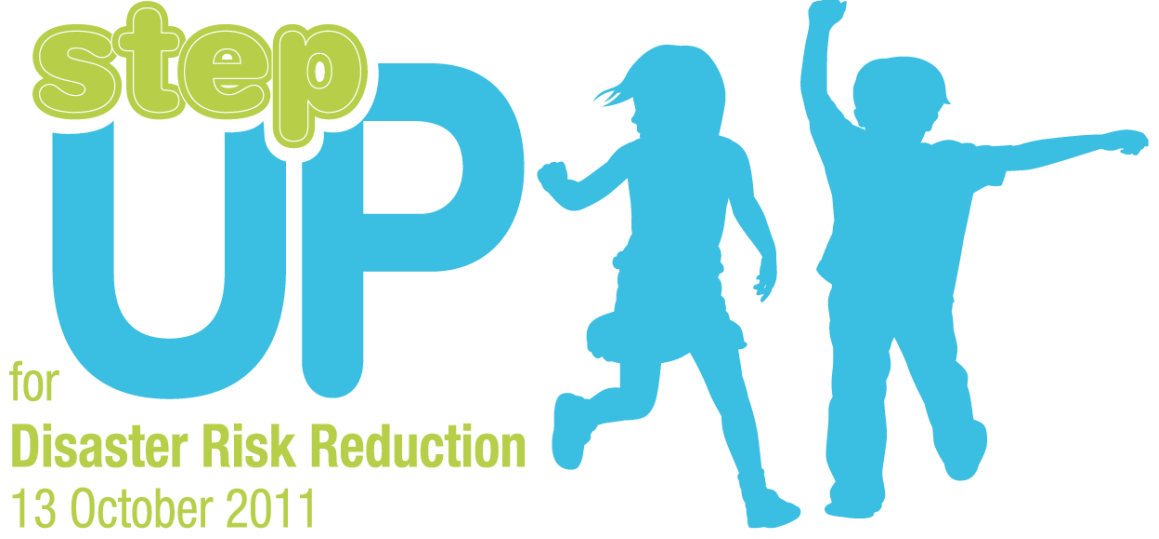

## PREFACE

The consequences of environmental deterioration and haphazard development have caused an unprecedented rise in the frequency and magnitude of disasters all over the world. Scientific findings endorse that human-induced faults enhance the risk of disasters, resulting in enormous loss of lives and property. While disasters affect everyone in the same way, the vulnerable groups- especially children, face the brunt of disasters with more severity and trauma. Factors such as their age affect their vulnerability and shape their ability to cope and survive in a disaster context.

Children have particular needs that must be met for their healthy growth and development. Aside from physical threat to life, experiences of fear, violence, separation from parents and caregivers, exploitation and abuse are threats to their well-being and development. Aside from being killed or injured, the loss of livelihood of their families can lead to homelessness and extreme poverty. Exposure to disaster can be a traumatic experience for children, affecting future full development potential.

Underpinning the critical need of children's and youth's participation in the disaster risk reduction, the 'United Nations International Strategy for Disaster Reduction Secretariat (UNISDR)' has decided to mark the International Day for Disaster Risk Reduction with focus on Children and Young People. The celebrations of the IDDRR 2011 shall be aptly echoed by a slogan- **“Step Up for Disaster Risk Reduction”**. The specific objectives of the IDDRR 2011 are as under-

- To let the world know that children and young people are partners in reducing disaster risk.
- To promote more partnerships with children and young people in disaster risk reduction
- To connect and build bridges and understanding among children and young people

As a symbol of solidarity with the global efforts to make the IDDRR 2011 a success, the Himachal Pradesh State Disaster Management Authority (HPSDMA) plans to organize a series of events starting from 8<sup>th</sup> of October 2011 (6<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the Kashmir Earthquake) to 13<sup>th</sup> of October 2011 (International Day for Disaster Risk Reduction 2011). These events will be components of a Mega Awareness & Capacity Building Campaign titled as- **SAMARTH 2011**.

## Following events will be organized during 'SAMARTH 2011':

### State Level Symposium

- A half-day long Conference on 'Importance of Volunteerism for Disaster Risk Reduction' at HP University organized by Institute of Integrated Himalayan Studies (IIHS), HPU in association with NSS & NCC.
- A Citizen's Solidarity March for Disaster Risk Reduction at the Mall Road organized by DDMA Shimla, MC Shimla and HPSDMA.
- A set of different mock-drills on quick and effective response (S&R and First Aid) during emergency situation.
- Hon'ble Chief Minister will address the citizens of HP in the presence of the MLAs and other dignitaries.
- Prize Distribution Ceremony
- Key stakeholders in the event shall be the Department of Civil Defense, HP Home Guards, Fire Services, Department of Education, HP University, NYKS, NCC and NSS.
- Quick Reference Guide (a small, multifold brochure) on Disaster Preparedness and Response shall be distributed among the masses.
