In exercise of the powers conferred by section 78 of the Disaster Management Act, 2005 (53 of 2005), the Governor of Himachal Pradesh is pleased to make the following rules to carry out the purposes of the Act *ibid*, namely:-

Short title	1. These rules may be called the Himachal Pradesh State Disaster Management Rules, 2011
Definitions	<p>2. (1) In these rules, unless the context otherwise requires:- (a) "Act" means the Disaster Management Act, 2005 (53 of 2005); and (b) "India" means a section of the Act;</p> <p>(2) Words and expressions used herein and not defined in these rules but defined in the Act, shall have the same meanings respectively as assigned to them in the Act.</p>
Term of office and conditions of service of Members of State Authority, [section 14(5)]	<p>3. (1) The term of the nominated non-official members of the State Authority shall be two years unless removed by State Government before completion of term of two years.</p> <p>(2) A nominated non-official member of the State Authority shall hold office at the pleasure of the Government.</p> <p>(3) The State Government may remove any nominated non-official member after affording him an opportunity of being heard.</p> <p>(4) Any nominated non-official member of the State Authority may resign from the office of member of the State Authority by giving a notice in writing under his hand to that effect to the Chairperson of the State Authority and such resignation shall take effect from the date on which such notice is accepted by the Chairperson.</p> <p>(5) Where a vacancy of nominated non-official member occurs in the office of the State Authority by reason of resignation, death or otherwise, the vacancy shall be filled by fresh nomination.</p>
